STUDENT CALL FOR APPLICATIONS Apple Developer Academy

Document reference: AppleDeveloperAcademyCall_20_21

GIVEN the Law of August 2nd, 1990, n. 241 “Nuove norme in materia di procedimento amministrativo e di diritto di accesso ai documenti amministrativi” [“New regulations on administrative procedures and the right of access to administrative documents”] and subsequent amendments and / or additions;

GIVEN the applicable University Statute;

GIVEN the *Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data* - hereinafter EU Regulation 2016/679 - relating to the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data, and the related National legislation of the *Code regarding the protection of personal data*, Legislative Decree N. 196/2003, as modified and integrated by Legislative Decree No. 101/2018;

CONSIDERING the *Regulation of the University of Naples Federico II* regarding the processing of personal data, issued with D.R. 2088/2019;

CONSIDERING the Scientific and Technological Cooperation Agreement signed between Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II and Apple, for the establishment of the Developer Academy, for the training in the development of new applications and digital services, with the purpose - among others

- to provide students admitted to the Developer Academy with the necessary skills to become "developers" of innovative apps, i.e. professionals who can design, implement and commercialize innovative services on Apple technological platforms;

CONSIDERING that, as provided for by the aforesaid Scientific and Technological Cooperation Agreement and the Exhibit A – Project Addendum 1, the students will be admitted to the Developer Academy after passing a specific selection;

GIVEN the Administration Board decree of 25th July 2016 and 27th October 2016 with which the administrative and accounting management of the Apple Developer Academy courses has been entrusted to the “Centro di Servizio di Ateneo per il Coordinamento dei Progetti Speciali e l’Innovazione Organizzativa dell’Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II COINOR”;

CONSIDERING also that, for the academic year 2020/2021 it is expected that a total number of 378 students will be admitted to the Developer Academy, of which 50 seats are for those who have already attended a Foundation Program, and 5 seats are for those who have already passed the written exam to an Indonesian Apple Developer Academy;

DECLARES

SECTION 1

(Announcement and number of seats)

This University announces a selection of 323 students to be admitted to the Apple Developer Academy.

The university reserves the right to increase the number of the students to a maximum of 378 in the event that the number of admitted students from the foundation announcement (**Document reference: AppleDeveloperAcademyFoundationCall_20_21**) is lower than 50 and/or the number of admitted students from the Apple Developer Academy in Indonesia announcement (**Document reference: AppleDeveloperAcademyIndonesiaCall_20_21**) is lower than 5.

The selection refers to the academic year 2020/2021.

SECTION 2

(Requirements for participation)

In order to be eligible for the selection mentioned in section 1, the applicant must have a valid High School level diploma in their home country, issued by upper-secondary educational institutions. The diploma must have been earned within the scholastic year 2019/2020 or earlier.

Candidates get a provisional admission to the selection. The University might decide to exclude any candidate, at any stage of this selection procedure, if the requirements are not fully met.

The applicants must not have already attended the Apple Developer Academy in Naples in the academic years 2016/2017, 2017/2018, 2018/2019, 2019/2020.

SECTION 3

(Application for participation in the selection procedure)

The application form must be submitted exclusively on-line through the following website: www.developeracademy.unina.it. The on-line registration is available since the publication date of this announcement, and will close mandatorily (and under penalty of exclusion from the selection procedure) **at 2pm (GMT+2) of September 11th 2020.**

Failure to comply with the regulations described in section A.2 of Annex A will prevent the admission to the selection and, in any case, result in an exclusion from the procedure.

Applicants with disabilities who require assistance to carry out the selection procedure must select "yes" in the "participants with special needs" box **and must send by September 10th 2020 at 2 pm (GMT+2) any request via e-mail to the following address: developeracademy@unina.it**. This is compulsory in order to receive any care and support service, as described in section A.2 of Annex A.

All communications concerning the selection will be given exclusively via on-line publication on the Official Noticeboard of the Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II (available at the University website www.unina.it) and by publication on the website www.developeracademy.unina.it

SECTION 4

(Evaluation Committee)

The Evaluation Committee will be appointed after the final deadline for submission of the participation applications. Its composition will be announced through a notice, published exclusively in the Official Noticeboard of the University (available at www.unina.it) and on the website www.developeracademy.unina.it

SECTION 5

(Selection procedure)

The admission exam will be in English and will consist of two phases:

- Assessment test
- Motivational interview

As better detailed in Section 6 of this document, the assessment test can take place either, on-line or in person, depending on the applicant's preferred option. For the on-line assessment, a limited number of seats is available. Such seats will be assigned on the basis of a First-Come-First-Served policy. In case the number of requests for on-line assessments exceeds the maximum quantity available, overflowing applicants will only be offered the alternative in person option for taking the exam.

Each applicant can only take the exam once.

Applicants who are admitted to the interview will be notified as described in section 7.

The selection procedure refers to section A.3 of Annex A, which is an integral part of this notice.

SECTION 6

(Admission tests: date and place of the evaluation test – execution modalities – candidate's obligations)

On-line tests

For this year's selection, the Academy is offering applicants to take the written exam on-line.

The on-line tests will be delivered through an on-line examination and proctoring platform, whose features and technical requirements will be described in detail in a dedicated page of the Apple Developer Academy web site (www.developeracademy.unina.it).

Seats at on-line sessions are limited. For this reason, access to on-line sessions will be granted on a First-Come-First-Served basis. Overflow applicants will be invited (via e-mail) to take their exams in-presence.

On-line sessions will be scheduled between **September 15 and October 2, 2020**.

The schedule might be subject to changes. The up-to-date schedule will be published on the Apple Developer Academy web site (www.developeracademy.unina.it) and on the website of the University of Naples Federico II (www.unina.it).

The timetable of the tests will be announced exclusively via on-line publication on the Official Noticeboard of the Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II (available on the web site www.unina.it) and on www.developeracademy.unina.it. This timetable will be published no later than 3 days before the beginning of the exams.

Any information related to the admission test will be made public only via the above mentioned means.

In person tests

In person tests will be held in Naples, Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II, Campus of San Giovanni a Teduccio, Corso Nicolangelo Protopisani 70 **between October 5 and October 9, 2020**.

The schedule might be subject to changes. The up-to-date schedule will be published on the Apple Developer Academy web site (www.developeracademy.unina.it) and on the website of the University of Naples Federico II (www.unina.it).

The timetable of the tests will be announced exclusively via on-line publication on the Official Noticeboard of the Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II (available on the web site www.unina.it) and on www.developeracademy.unina.it. This timetable will be published no later than 7 days before the beginning of the exams.

Any information related to the admission test will be made public only via the above mentioned means.

The applicants who successfully applied for the in person admission test, according to section 3 above, must arrive at the time and in the day indicated in the convocation notice at the university location assigned to them, with a valid identification document (photo ID, passport). Applicants who, for any reason, are absent at the test in accordance with the timetable, will be deemed to have withdrawn.

During the test, applicants are not allowed to communicate between each other. Applicants cannot use or even hold mobile phones, smartphones, palmtops, electronic devices of any type and any suitable means for information storage or data transmission and also writing paper, handwritten or typed notes, books, publications, manuals, textbooks and reference materials, on pain of annulment of the test.

Applicants must remain in their seats until at least thirty (30) minutes before the expiration of the provided sixty (60) examination minutes. The applicant infringing the regulations of this section shall be excluded from the selection process.

SECTION 7

(Admission test: date and venue of the interview - implementation procedure)

The ranking list of the applicants admitted to the interview will be communicated exclusively by on-line publication on the Official Noticeboard of the Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II (available at www.unina.it) and by publication on the website www.developeracademy.unina.it.

Date and time of the interview will be communicated in the same way. The interview will take place on-line (via video conference), in accordance with the procedures mentioned in section A.3 of Annex A.

SECTION 8

(Publication of the ranking list)

The merit ranking list will be drawn up only on the basis of the scores obtained in the assessment tests and in the interview.

In the event of a tie, the younger candidate shall prevail. The final ranking list will be published in the Official Noticeboard of the Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II (available on www.unina.it) and on the website www.developeracademy.unina.it.

SECTION 9

(Economic support funds)

There will be both monetary rewards and an attendance allowance for those who successfully complete the Academy experience. They will be delivered at least one month after the end of the project. They will also be subject to constraints that come directly from the European Commission policies (associated with the funds being leveraged through Regione Campania).

In order to be eligible for the economic support, the applicant must:

-hold a High school diploma issued by upper-secondary educational institutions or, if not obtained in Italy, an equivalent qualification. The diploma must have been obtained no later than scholastic year 2019/2020

-be unemployed (under the current regulation¹) and preserve the state of unemployment for the entire duration of the course.

The applicants commit themselves to providing to the Administration Office, when requires, any documents needed in order to prove the requirements of the call.

If Apple would decide to award a financial support to the students, this support will be not compatible with the regional contribution.

SECTION 10

(Procedure of acceptance)

The candidates admitted have to formalize their attendance to Apple Developer Academy by signing an agreement by which the admitted person undertakes to comply with the provisions of this selection notice, included the documents required in order to get the economic support.

Once the deadline for acceptance has expired, if there are any places left due to lack of acceptance or

subsequent withdrawal, the ranking will be scrolled. Any scrolling and the relative terms for making acceptances will be communicated exclusively by publication on the website of the University of Naples

SECTION 11

(Access to documents, Information regarding personal data)

Applicants have access to documents concerning the competition procedure, in accordance with the current legislation. SECTION 12

(Privacy and information on personal data)

In accordance with the art. 13 of the EU Regulation 679/2016, the personal data collected will be processed for the purposes of the procedure for which they are released and will be used exclusively for this purpose and in any case within the Institutional activities of the University. The online publication in the Official Noticeboard of the Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II has the force of notification with all effects and no personal messages will be sent to interested parties. Therefore, it is recommended a constant consultation of the web links above.

SECTION 14

(Final Provisions)

The University reserves the right to exclude at any time the applicants participating in the procedure pursuant to this notice for failure to comply with its provisions or within the time specified or for default of the applicants' requirements. The exclusions are made with a Chancellor Decree. Exclusions will be notified exclusively by online publication in the Official Noticeboard of the Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II (available at the site www.unina.it), as well as by publication of the exclusion decree on the website www.developeracademy.unina.it.
