THE PIER ANNEX

The concept

The Apple Developer Academy is recruiting up to 12 professionals, from previous Academy graduates, to be part of the Pier programme. The Pier developers will receive a MacBook Pro and an iPhone for the duration of their contract, will have access to Academy resources as well as a number of new benefits offered exclusively for Pier members.

The projects

As a Pier member, you will have the chance to work on projects throughout the year with external stakeholders, enabling you to further develop your skills and take them to the next level. In addition, you will have access to several opportunities to improve your CV and develop your career in a chosen path.

The Pier has strong relationships with third parties, including NGO organisations, and local community organisations, so during your stay, you will be contributing to at least one of them.

Your performance will be measured by a combination of your contributions to the external stakeholder projects, as well as your commitment and dedication to the program and your team.

You will retain intellectual property of personal projects you may eventually develop, along with your chosen group members, as you are used to from your Academy experience. However, you will not necessarily retain intellectual property of any external stakeholder projects.

The Pier Manager will define the groups for the external projects, based on the scope of the project, Pier members competencies and Pier members aspirations.

The Pier developers will also be asked to contribute to the Academy by helping build tools, assisting the mentors and students, and also helping the Apple Foundation Program across the Campania region.

For the academic year 2021/2022 The Pier at Apple Developer Academy will welcome on board 12 students, who have applied for the default selection procedure

1. Date of the course

- o Expected start date of courses: Mid of November 2021
- o Expected end date of courses: End of June 2022.

2. Application form and registration procedure.

The application form must be submitted exclusively on-line through the following website: www.developeracademy.unina.it. The on line registration is available from the publication date of this announcement, and will close mandatorily (and under penalty of exclusion from the selection procedure) at 2 pm (CEST) of November 10th 2021. 4. Location

The training will take place at the Apple Developer Academy, Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II, Campus of San Giovanni a Teduccio, Corso Nicolangelo Protopisani 70, Naples, Italy.

5. Attendance of the Classes

Class attendance is mandatory. Participants are required to respect the minimum limit of attendance, which is 80% of the scheduled hours (20 hours a week).

6. Scholarships and economic support fund

Apple decided to award a financial support to the Pier student. This amount will be delivered every two months.
