### STUDENT CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

**GIVEN** the Law of August 2nd, 1990, n. 241 "Nuove norme in materia di procedimento amministrativo e di diritto di accesso ai documenti amministrativi" ["New regulations on administrative procedures and the right of access to administrative documents"] and subsequent amendments and / or additions;

**GIVEN** the applicable University Statute;

**GIVEN** the legislative decree of June 30th, 2003, n. 196 "Codice in materia di dati personali" ["Personal Data Code"], as implemented with the Internal Regulations on the Implementation of Personal Data Protection Code used by the University, issued by D.R. n. 5073 dated 30.12.2005;

**CONSIDERING** the Scientific and Technological Cooperation Agreement signed between Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II and Apple, for the establishment of Developer Academy, for the training in the development of new applications and digital services, with the purpose - among others - to provide students admitted to the Developer Academy with the necessary skills to become "developer" of innovative apps, i.e. professionals who can design, implement and commercialize innovative services on Apple technological platforms;

**CONSIDERING** that, as provided for by the aforesaid Scientific and Technological Cooperation Agreement and the Exhibit A – Project Addendum 1, the students will be admitted to the Developer Academy after passing a specific selection;

**GIVEN** the Agreement signed on 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2016 between the Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II and Regione Campania for the establishment of the Developer Academy Project;

**GIVEN** the Administration Board decree of 25<sup>th</sup> July 2016 and 27<sup>th</sup> October 2016 with which the administrative and accounting management has been entrusted to the Centro di Servizio di



Ateneo per il Coordinamento dei Progetti Speciali e l'Innovazione Organizzativa dell'Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II - COINOR;

**CONSIDERING** also that, for the academic year 2018/2019 it is expected that a total number of 378 students will be admitted to the Developer Academy;

## **DECLARES**

### **SECTION 1**

#### **(Announcement and number of seats)**

This University announces a selection of **378** students to be admitted at the Apple Developer Academy. The course is divided into two education paths:

- **Standard Class: 342**
- **Enterprise Track: 36**

**The two education paths are described in detail in section A.1 of Annex A, which is part of this announcement.**

The selection refers to the academic year 2018/2019.

### **SECTION 2**

#### **(Requirements for participation)**

In order to be eligible for the selection mentioned in section 1, applicants must be EU or NON-EU citizens who meet the requirements described below in section 2a. The requirements must be met on the start date of each training course described in this announcement.

Candidates are admitted to the selection with condition. The University might decide to exclude any candidate, at any stage of this selection procedure, if the requirements are not fully met.

#### **SECTION 2a**

##### **(Requirements for participating at the Standard Class)**

- High school diploma issued by upper-secondary educational institutions or, if not obtained in Italy, an equivalent qualification. The diploma must have been earned within the scholastic year 2017/2018 or earlier.

**For Standard Classes applicants must not have already attended the Apple Developer Academy in Naples in the academy years 2016/2017 or 2017/2018.**



## SECTION 2b

### (Requirements for participating at the Enterprise Track)

In order to be eligible for the selection mentioned in section 1, applicants must be EU or NON-EU citizens who hold:

- Advanced University Degree in IT or Computer Science obtained according to the criteria prior to D.M. 509/99, or an Italian Laurea Specialistica obtained under D.M. 509/99, or an Italian Laurea Magistrale pursuant to D.M. 270/04 or if not obtained in Italy an equivalent qualification;

or

1. Any Advanced University Degree achieved according to the criteria prior to D.M. 509/99, or an Italian Laurea Specialistica obtained under D.M. 509/99, or an Italian Laurea Magistrale pursuant to D.M. 270/04 or, if not obtained in Italy, an equivalent qualification;
2. Demonstrated work experience of 2+ years in an IT related field.

Students must have met the requirements at the expiry date of the call, **which is on June 8<sup>th</sup> 2018.**

**For the Enterprise Track applicants must not have already attended the Apple Developer Academy- Master Class in Naples during the academic year 2017/2018.**

## SECTION 3

### (Application for participation to the selection procedure)

**The applicants can apply for Standard Class or for Enterprise Track, or if they meet the requirements, for both Standard Class and Enterprise Track.**

The application form must be submitted exclusively on-line through the following website: [www.developeracademy.unina.it](http://www.developeracademy.unina.it). The on-line registration is available from the publication date of this announcement, and will close mandatorily (and under penalty of exclusion from the selection procedure) **at 14:00hrs (GMT+1) of June 8<sup>th</sup> 2018.**

**Failure to comply with the regulations described in section A.2 of Annex A will implicate the non-admission to the selection and, in any case, the exclusion from the procedure.**

Applicants with disabilities who require assistance to carry out the selection procedure should select "yes" in the "participants with special needs" box **and must send by June 15<sup>th</sup> 2018 at 14.00hrs (GMT+1) any request via e-mail at the following address: [developeracademy@unina.it](mailto:developeracademy@unina.it).** This is compulsory in order to receive any care and support service, as described in Annex a.2.

## SECTION 4

### (Evaluation Committee)

The Evaluation Committee will be appointed after the final deadline for submission of the participation applications. Its composition will be announced through a notice, published exclusively in the Official Noticeboard of the University (available at [www.unina.it](http://www.unina.it)) and on the website [www.developeracademy.unina.it](http://www.developeracademy.unina.it)

## SECTION 5

### (Selection procedure)

The admission exam will be in English and will consist of two phases:

- Assessment test
- Interview

Those admitted to the interview will receive the communication of the admission as described in section 7.

**The selection procedure refers to section A.3 of Annex A, which is part of this notice.**

## SECTION 6

### (Admission tests: date and place of the evaluation test – execution modalities – candidate's obligations)

The evaluation test will be held in Naples, on the ground floor of the Federico II University - Biotechnology Sciences Campus in **Via De Amicis 95, from July 2<sup>nd</sup> 2018.**

The schedule might be subject to changes. The up-to-date schedule will be published on the Apple Developer Academy web site ([www.developeracademy.unina.it](http://www.developeracademy.unina.it)) and on the website of the University of Naples Federico II ([www.unina.it](http://www.unina.it)).

The timetable of the tests will be announced exclusively via on-line publication on the Official Noticeboard of the Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II (available on the web site [www.unina.it](http://www.unina.it)) and on [www.developeracademy.unina.it](http://www.developeracademy.unina.it). This timetable will be published no later than 7 days before the beginning of the exams.

For this year's selection, the Academy is offering applicants to sit for on-line assessment also in one of the following remote examination sites: **London, Munich, Paris.**

The seats at remote sessions are limited. For this reason, access to remote sessions will be granted on a First-Come-First-Served basis. Overflow applicants will be invited (via e-mail) to take their exams in Naples.

Possible postponements of the dates will be announced on the Official Noticeboard of the Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II is authentic.

Any information related to the admission test will be made public only via the above mentioned mean.

The applicants who successfully applied for the admission test, according to the previous section 3, must arrive at the time and in the day indicated in the convocation notice at the university location assigned to them, with a valid identification document (ID card, passport).. Applicants who, for any reason, are absent at the test in according with the timetable, will be deemed to have withdrawn.

During the test, applicants are not allowed to communicate between each other. Applicants, on pain of exclusion, cannot use or even hold mobile phones, smartphones, palmtops, electronic devices of any type and any suitable means for information storage or data transmission and also writing paper, handwritten or typed notes, books, publications, manuals, textbooks and reference materials, during the test, on pain of annulment of the test.

Applicants must remain in their seats until at least thirty (30) minutes before the expiration of the provided sixty (60) examination minutes for Standard Classes and forty-five (45) minutes before the expiration of the provided ninety (90) examination minutes for Enterprise Track. The applicant infringing the regulations of this section shall be excluded from the selection process.

## SECTION 7

### **(Admission test: date and venue of the interview - performing procedure)**

The ranking lists (Standard Classes 500 and Enterprise Track 70) of the applicants admitted to the interview will be known exclusively by on-line publication on the Official Noticeboard of the Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II (available on [www.unina.it](http://www.unina.it)) and by publication on the website [www.developeracademy.unina.it](http://www.developeracademy.unina.it).

Date and time of the interview will be given in the same way. The interview will take place on-line (via video conference), in accordance with the procedures mentioned in section A.3 of Annex A.

## SECTION 8

### **(Publication of the lists)**

The merit ranking lists (Standard Classes and Enterprise Track) will be drawn up only on the basis of the scores obtained in the assessment tests and in the interview.

In the event of a tie, the younger shall prevail. The final ranking lists will be published in the Official Noticeboard of the Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II (available on [www.unina.it](http://www.unina.it)) and on the web site [www.developeracademy.unina.it](http://www.developeracademy.unina.it).



The students admitted to both Standard Classes and Enterprise Track will be able to choose the education path to attend within 3 days to the date of the Administration request. In the event that the admitted student does not choose the Class to attend, he/she will be excluded from the Academy.

Applicants who are called for the final interview but not placed among the admitted 378 participants, will have to undertake again the whole selection procedure for the subsequent academic years of the Apple Developer Academy.

## **SECTION 9**

### **(Scholarship and economic support funds)**

Apple has made available a number of scholarships equal to the 5% of the students admitted to the Developer Academy, in accordance with the final ranking.

All other students admitted will receive a contribution from Regione Campania, in accordance with the Agreement signed between the University and Regione Campania of the 22 November 2016, based on the applicable European regulations (see European Social Fund regulations) at the end of the course.

## **SECTION 10**

### **(Access to documents, Information regarding personal data)**

Applicants have access to documents concerning the competition procedure, in accordance with the current legislation. This right will be exercised in the manner prescribed by the University Regulations laying down the rules on administrative procedure and the right of access to documents, issued with the Chancellor Decree n. 2386/98 and subsequent amendments and additions. According to section 13 of the law n. 196/2003, please note that the Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II is responsible for processing personal data of applicants, in accordance with the provisions of the Rules of implementation of personal data protection code used by the University, issued by D.R. n. 5073 of 30th December 2005 and subsequent amendments. |
